## ***SCAPHON Childhood Hematology Survivor Scholarship***

### **PURPOSE**

To establish a means where SCAPHON is able to provide a Scholarship to individuals who have received treatment at a Southern California Institution for a hematological disorder, including but not exclusive to Thalassemia, Sickle Cell disease, hemophilia, or Blackfan Diamond Anemia and are planning to obtain a post high-school education (College/University, Community/Junior College, or Vocational School).

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- The applicant must be an individual treated for a hematologic disorder
- The applicant has made a commitment to post high-school education
- The applicant must be a resident of Southern California
- Application can be submitted each year, but can only receive the Scholarship once

### **Application Checklist**

- Complete Educational Scholarship application
- Submit one page personal essay
- Include proof of acceptance and/or copy of recent transcripts from your college/university
- Submit completed material to address on application form
- Include reference letters

### **AWARDING FUNDS**

A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded each year. The recipient will receive the award upon approval by the SCAPHON board.

### **AWARDING SCHOLARSHIPS**

Members of the Board of Directors of the Association of Pediatric Hematology Oncology Nurses, Southern California Chapter, will process the applications and make a determination for the award. The recipient will be notified by mail. The award will be announced at the SCAPHON annual conference held in May.

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
