## **SCAPHON Childhood Cancer Survivor Scholarships**

### **PURPOSE**

To establish a means where SCAPHON is able to provide a Scholarship to individuals who have received treatment at a Southern California Institution for a cancer diagnosis including, but not exclusive to, Leukemia, Osteosarcoma, Neuroblastoma, or a CNS Tumor, and are planning to obtain a post high-school education (College/University, Community/Junior College, or Vocational School).

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Applicant must be an individual treated for a cancer diagnosis
- Applicant has made a commitment to post high-school education
- Applicant must be a resident of Southern California
- Application can be submitted each year, but can only receive the Scholarship once  
**(NOTE: Each application will be considered for all four Childhood Cancer Survivor Scholarships. There is no need to submit an application for each one separately.)**

### **Application Checklist**

- Complete Educational Scholarship application
- Submit one page personal essay
- Include proof of acceptance and/or copy of recent transcripts from your college/university
- Submit completed material to address on application form
- Include reference letters

### **AWARDING FUNDS**

A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded each year. The recipient will receive the award upon approval by the SCAPHON board.

### **AWARDING SCHOLARSHIPS**

Members of the Board of Directors of the Association of Pediatric Hematology Oncology Nurses, Southern California Chapter, will process the applications and make a determination for the award. The recipient will be notified by mail. The award will be announced at the SCAPHON annual conference held in June.

**Applications must be postmarked by April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.**
