PURPOSE

To provide educational scholarships to individuals who have received treatment at a Southern California Institution for a hematology disorder, including but not exclusive to, Thalassemia, Sickle Cell Disease, Hemophilia, or Blackfan Diamond Anemia, and are planning to obtain a post high-school education (College/University, Community/Junior College, or Vocational School).

ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant must be an individual treated for a hematological disorder
- The applicant has made a commitment to post high-school education
- The applicant must be a resident of Southern California
- Application can be submitted each year, but can only receive the Scholarship once

Upload proof of acceptance and/or copy of recent transcripts from your current college/university

Upload two letters of reference

AWARDING FUNDS

\$1000 scholarships will be awarded each year. The recipients will receive the awards upon approval by the Southern California Association of Pediatric Hematology Oncology Nurses (SCAPHON) board.

AWARDING SCHOLARSHIPS

Members of the Board of Directors of SCAPHON will process the applications and make a determination for the award. The recipients will be notified by email. The awards will be announced at the SCAPHON annual conference.
